

**Cedar Lake Township
Right-of-Way**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is a misdemeanor to pile or push snow from a private driveway onto public roadways and right-of-way. Residents must observe right-of-way when removing snow or other debris from their property. “Minnesota Statute 160.2715 Right-of-Way Use: Misdemeanors. (a) Except for the actions of the road authorities, their agents, employees, contractor, and utilities in carrying out their duties imposed by law or contract, and except as herein provided, it shall be unlawful to: (1) obstruct any highway or deposit snow or ice thereon: (2) plow or perform any other detrimental operation within the road right-of-way except in the preparation of the land for planting permanent vegetative cover or as authorized under section 160.232”. This misdemeanor portion of the Statute also covers fences, structures, obstructions, removal of earth, gravel or rock within the right-of-way.
